6b. Trial court proceedings were stayed while Defendants pursued an appeal and Plaintiff pursued a writ of mandamus. The case has now been remanded to the trial court, which adjudicated the pending demurrer/motion to strike, motion for fictitious name, and motion for intervention. Per the Court's order on the demurrer/motion to strike, Plaintiff filed a first amended complaint on December 21, 2023 and Defendant Cisco filed an answer on January 23, 2024. Plaintiff is current seeking leave to amend the complaint. The parties have commenced written discovery. Plaintiff CRD would propose a trial date in approximately sixteen months from the date of the March 2024 Case Management Conference.
